



## **REDEEMED...RECEIVED POWER... COMMISSIONED TO GO AND DO**

Scriptures: 2 Tim 3:11, Romans 10:17, Proverbs 4:20

In the early Church, they had the revelation of the redemptive power of the cross.

- a) They depended on the power of God to put them in a winning position
- b) The believers put him (satan) under their feet
- c) Satan was under the control of the believers

This revelation began to dissipate in time. The mighty Church of God went into a time when the scripture was hidden from the believers

As stated in Romans 10:17 Now faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God. – When people hear Gods word

- a) on salvation – they get saved
- b) on Holy Spirit – they get filled & speak with other tongues
- c) on healing – they get healed
- d) on prosperity – they gather abundance

The reason people don't come to the church for healing is that they haven't heard and don't know that healing is IN the church.

2. John 10:10 I have come that you might have life and have it more abundantly.

Abundant (whole) life includes physical, emotional, spiritual and financial healing. Your healing is important to God. Freedom from ALL bondage is God's desire for you.

- My Words are life
- Health to ALL their flesh
- Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit
- God gives you power to get wealth and health in order to establish His kingdom on the earth
- The reason Jesus turned the power over to his body (the church) is that we have dominion here on earth. (Mark 16:15) Kingdom Living

3. Jesus trained his followers to carry on

- a) John 14:9
- b) Gal 3:13

He authorized his disciples to do all that he did and MORE.

Jesus gave them power over unclean spirits

They had freely received power and were told to freely give.





4. Jesus came as a representative of God. The Father had anointed Jesus to do His own works!  
Acts 10:38, John 14:12
5. We are NOW Jesus' representatives on this earth. We are anointed with the Holy Spirit to go about doing good and healing ALL that are oppressed of the devil.
  - a) "As my Father has sent me – so send I you" (John 20:21)
  - b) Believers should be walking in the anointing and power of God, just like Jesus did
  - c) Can you say "If you have seen me you have seen Jesus"?
  - d) We ARE the body of Christ on this earth
  - e) When you deal with one that God has sent, you are dealing with God because that person is God's representative
  - f) We see how Jesus treated His disciples and kept them WITH him while he trained them. He loved them into their positions and trusted them with the great commission when He left.
  - g) We are to treat each other with that same kind of respect and love. Does the world know we are followers by the Love that we have for one another?
  - h) We are still functioning as part of the Book of Acts – It is NOT over Till its Over.

RELIGION DILUTED THE POWER OF CHRIST WITH ITS DESIRE FOR PERSONAL POWER FOR YEARS. Because of this many people thought that miracles had passed away completely.

- a) We are here to RESUME our place in the Body of Christ. All of you here want to go out and pray for people to be healed and to see them be healed. We do not need to go to other countries.
- b) There is plenty to do within the church and our own community. It should be impressive if we become effective right here.
- c) Gods will is that there be NO feeble among us. No matter how young or old we are. If this was available in the Old Testament, It is surely available to us now.





## OUTLINE

Jesus earth walk was the demonstration of God's perfect will.

- He was sent by God
- He said "If you have seen me, you have seen the father" (John 14:9)
- Forgiving sin and healing the sick are God's will

Jesus sent the Apostles, disciples, Church to the same works (John 20:21)

- He gave us power over sickness and death and devils (Matt 10:40)
- Jesus was anointed by God (Acts 10:38)
- We are anointed by the same Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8)
